Truck deliveries in February 2009

Total deliveries from the Volvo Group's truck operations in February amounted to 10,863 vehicles. This was a decrease of 51%, compared with the year-earlier period.

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Volvo Trucks

The deliveries in February declined with 49% compared with the year-earlier period. The lower demand is now affecting all markets to different extent, with the exception of Africa, where the deliveries still were higher in comparison to last year.

The high percentage increase of North American deliveries in February was due to a relatively low number of deliveries in February 2008 because of a strike in the New River Valley factory.

There is a continued low demand for trucks in Europe. The deliveries in February were down with 68%, mainly because of a big decrease in deliveries in Eastern Europe, where the decline was 90%.

The current focus is on maintaining good customer relationships, taking care of the aftermarket business and to safeguard the cash flow.

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Mack

Mack deliveries in February totaled 942 vehicles, down 29% (from 1,334) compared with the year-earlier period. Although the high average age in the market's existing truck population indicates pent-up replacement demand, continued economic uncertainty, low freight volumes and tight credit are continuing to weigh on the industry. Mack expects, with some lead-time, certain positive effects on demand as a result of government stimulus, and moves by the Federal Reserve to create greater liquidity.

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Renault Trucks

At the end of February 2009 the total deliveries of light, medium and heavy duty vehicles from Renault Trucks were less than half of what they were in February 2008, with a total decline of 55%. Deliveries in France are resisting better than in the rest of Europe, and the decline was 39%.

In spite of the tough situation, Renault Trucks is preparing for the future and recently presented a long haul Premium truck (Optifuel Lab) that is reducing carbon dioxide emissions by lowering fuel consumption by 13% through aerodynamic features on the vehicle and its trailer, and an optimised driveline.

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Nissan Diesel

Deliveries from Nissan Diesel in February totaled 1,344 units, which was a decrease by 68%. In Asia, the number of deliveries was 940 units, a decrease by 72%. In Japan, the number of deliveries was 639 units, a decrease by 70%. In Middle East Asia, the number of deliveries was 75 units, a decrease by 73%.
