Truck deliveries in October 2010

Total deliveries from the Volvo Group's truck operations in October amounted to 17,642 vehicles. This was an increase of 35% compared with the year-earlier period.

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Volvo Trucks

Globally, deliveries in October were 68% higher than in the corresponding month last year. The deliveries to Europe amounted to 3,442 trucks, 90% up compared to the year earlier period. Year to date 22,287 trucks were delivered in Europe, which is up 39% from last year.

In South America the deliveries in October are up 38%, supported by growing domestic markets. The demand continues to be strong in Brazil, and increased deliveries to Peru, Argentina and Chile can also be noted during October. So far this year, the deliveries in South America have increased by 91% to 14 917 trucks.

In North America the deliveries sum up to 9,488 trucks year-to-date, with 1 651 trucks delivered during October. An increase by 93% compared to the same month 2009.

Deliveries in Asia are up 76% year-to-date, and 48% up for the isolated month.

Mack

Mack's deliveries in October totaled 1,373 vehicles, up 28% compared with the year-earlier period.

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While demand for Class 8 construction trucks remains weak, activity has picked up in the highway segment of the market. Customer response to the company's EPA2010 trucks continues to be very positive.

Renault Trucks

Deliveries from Renault Trucks in October increased by 21% compared with the year-earlier period, mainly due to heavy duty trucks (+46%).

For the first ten months the total deliveries increased by 13%. The Renault Premium Route has won an independent customer's test in Germany in terms of running cost and fuel consumption, and deliveries have increased during 2010.

UD Trucks

Deliveries from UD Trucks in October totaled 2,052 units, which was a decrease of 12% compared with the year-earlier period.

In Asia, the number of deliveries was 1,522 units, down 22%.

In South East Asia, the number of deliveries was 389 units, up 30%. In Indonesia, the recovering mining operation had a positive effect on truck demand.

In Japan, the number of deliveries in October was 988 units, a decrease of 32%. The end of the government subsidy program in 2010 which started last year brought down the entire demand.

In North America, the number of deliveries increased by 125%. Demand for trucks mounted with the new medium-duty engine which meets US 10 emission standards is increasing.

In South Africa, demand is increasing and the deliveries in October were up by 48%.
